## **Advisory Committee**

<u>Mission:</u> Review federal, state and local development proposals and other activities to determine whether the plans appropriately address the long term preservation, protection and enhancement of the Wood-Pawcatuck Watershed Wild and Scenic Rivers. Recommend what advocacy is needed to ensure the outstandingly remarkable values (ORVs) of cultural, scenic and recreational, exceptional ecosystems and hydrology/ geology are protected and preserved.

<u>Primary Duties:</u> Review potential activities that will threaten or enhance the ORVs of the Wood-Pawcatuck Wild and Scenic Rivers. Offer guidance as to what additional actions may enhance proposed projects that would support the implementation of the Stewardship Plan.

## Activities:

- 1. Review / advocate for, or against, policies and ordinances / comprehensive plans / state laws. The committee will make recommendations to the Council for their decision.
- 2. Assist communities in identifying additional resources that they can pursue.
- 3. Interact with Stewardship Council members as they provide the Advisory Committee useful information.
- 4. When enhancement projects are endorsed, recommend them to the Stewardship Projects Committee for consideration of support.
- 5. Develop Standard Operating Procedures.
