Mission: Revision of the Council's Bylaws; Drafting new Council Policies

<u>Primary Duties:</u> Work with all committee members to identify appropriate bylaw revisions and additional sections where needed. Draft bylaws and policies revisions; provide the Council drafts for review and final approval.

<u>Duties may include (with staff assistance)</u>:

- 1. Assure the content and any revisions reflect the Stewardship Plan
- 2. Assure the wording/terms are consistent throughout the document
- 3. Assure there are key sections that clearly describe membership, functions, procedures, and responsibilities.
- 4. Allow for constructive deliberations to resolve any points where members have differing opinions
- 5. Solicit suggestions for changes to the bylaws from the Council
- Review the following sections of the bylaws for any gaps that exist or sections that need clarification: Introduction, Mission and Purpose, Membership, Officers, Meeting and Voting, Policies- Conflict of Interest, Indemnification and Amendments.
- 7. Confirm that suggested revisions are needed and the extent of revisions are appropriate for what's needed
- 8. Present Bylaw revisions to the Council and seek approval
- 9. Revise current policies and/or draft new policies to support bylaws
- 10. Present policies to the Council and seek approval.
- 11. Conduct yearly review of bylaws to confirm they are consistent with the purpose of the Council.
